Plaintiff Omar Zine respectfully submits that this case is related to *Abdo Ghazi v. Uber Technologies, Inc., et al.*, San Francisco Superior Court Case No. CGC-15-545532, filed on April 28, 2015, assigned to Hon. Curtis E.A. Karnow in Department 304 in the Civic Center Courthouse, located at 400 McAllister Street, San Francisco, California 94102.

The cases involve the same Uber defendants and are based on the same or similar claims. (Cal. Rules of Court, Rule 3.300(a)(1)). Plaintiffs are challenging Uber's failure to provide workers' compensation after they were assaulted on the job in the foreseeable manner. The matters also "[a]rise from the same or substantially identical questions of law or fact" as to part of one of the three alleged actions in the instant matter: (1) the Unfair and Unlawful Competition (Cal. *Bus & Prof. Code* § 17200 et seq.) Because of the similarity in the allegations of the instant action and the currently related cases, these cases "[a]re likely... to require substantial duplication of judicial resources if heard by different judges." (Cal. Rules of Court, Rule 3.300(a)(4)).
